Day 3: Mon, Mar 17

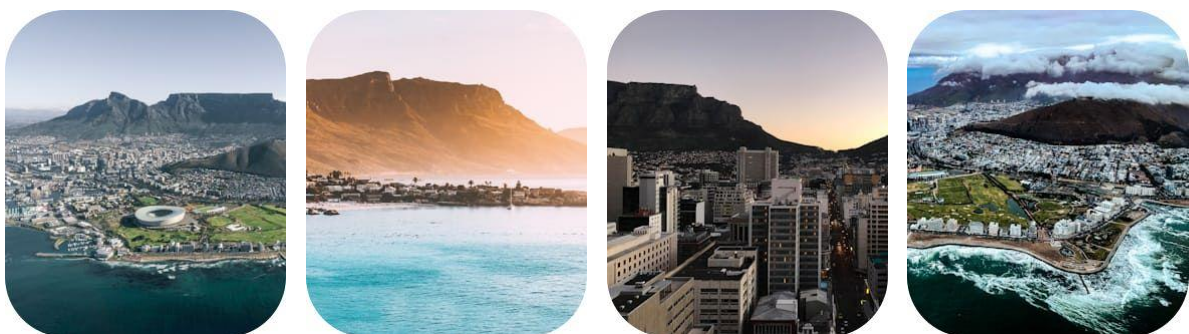
Take advantage of a free afternoon to explore bustling Cape Town on your own.

Start with a walk through Bo-Kaap, a historic neighborhood at the foot of Leeuwkop Mountain. The neighborhood is known for its brightly colored cottages that have much in common with Malay and Islamic architecture. You can have fun strolling the narrow, cobblestone streets and visit the oldest mosque in South Africa.

In the afternoon, you can continue walking to Cape Town's vibrant center: V&A Waterfront. Here you can enjoy a delicious meal, browse the many boutique stores, take a look at the sea lions that moor here to rest, take a boat trip from the harbor and dine blissfully in the cozy food market. The many street performers also provide plenty of ambiance every day.

Daily boats also depart from the V&A Waterfront for Robben Island, the prison where Nelson Mandela was held for 27 years. The sight of the desolate prison camp and the many photos and videos you are shown leave a deep impression. If you want to visit this prison camp, be sure to book your ticket for the ferry and the tour of the island in advance.

The best way to end the day is on Table Mountain, the symbol of Cape Town. Hiking up is more challenging than it looks at first glance: the loose rocks and steep slopes are difficult. Fortunately, you can easily traverse the 1086 meters altitude by cable car. At the top, you will be rewarded with breathtaking views of the city, the ocean and the surrounding mountains. So for a spectacular sunset you really are in the right place here.

Via Boulders Beach to the Cape of Good Hope

Day 4: Tue, Mar 18

Enjoy a hearty breakfast and then drive to Boulders Beach in Simon's Town, an idyllic white beach with rather unique inhabitants. Hundreds of African penguins have made this beach their own, forming a large colony over the years. You can watch and photograph the penguins up close as they waddle around and play in their natural habitat. Make Boulders Beach the first stop on your drive to see the penguins awaken from their slumber, as well as get ahead of the large groups of tourists.

From Simon's Town you drive easily on to the Cape Peninsula, but not without a tasty lunch stop. On the way to the Cape of Good Hope you pass the charming Black Marlin Restaurant, a hidden gem with delicious fish dishes and accompanying local wines. From the restaurant you also have an unparalleled view of the ocean. A must-do while visiting the Cape Peninsula.

Finally, you continue on your way to the Cape of Good Hope, a nature reserve at the southernmost point of the peninsula, where the Atlantic and Indian Oceans meet. Some not-to-be-missed beaches and viewpoints here include Platboom Beach, Buffalo Bay Beach, New Cape Point Lighthouse and, of course, the Cape of Good Hope. Along the way, also keep your eyes open for large ostriches, wild baboons, African eland and even some zebras.

Today you head to the wine city par excellence: Stellenbosch, South Africa's second largest wine-producing region. Its beautiful landscapes surrounded by mountains, rolling hills and vast vineyards make this city a popular destination even for non-wine lovers. The drive to Stellenbosch takes one hour.

Upon arrival at the hotel, you will receive a personal tour of Hazendal's wineries, where you can also taste three fine wines. Then head to the attached restaurant for a light lunch (lunch not included).

Take advantage of a free afternoon and evening to hike in the nearby Jonkershoek Nature Reserve, a beautiful nature reserve with steep mountain peaks, waterfalls, lush forests and several hiking trails. Another popular afternoon activity is the "high tea" on the hotel's lawn: you get a picnic blanket, a table and a beanbag with which to stretch out in the grass. Tip: order the decadent chocolate cake for the ultimate high tea.

Via Tradouw Pass to Oudtshoorn

Day 7: Fri, Mar 21

Today you will follow the beautiful Tradouw Pass to the other side of the mountains to Oudtshoorn, a drive of about 5 hours. Set your GPS to the final destination, but add the village of Swellendam as a stopover. That way you'll be sure to pass the beautiful Tradouw Pass. Plus, you'll find some cozy restaurants in Swellendam where you can stop for a well-deserved lunch break.

Just after you leave Swellendam, the road climbs over the Andre Uys Bridge to the heart of the Langeberg where there are a number of vantage points. Then the

pass descends through a narrow gorge to Barrydale, from where you can continue on into Little Karoo, a beautiful wine region with hot springs and clear streams.

Today is all about panoramic routes, because after Tradouw Pass you will continue along Route 62 to Oudtshoorn. Route 62 is one of the most famous routes in South Africa and also the longest wine route in the world. Everywhere you look you see winding mountain passes, vineyards and farms.

Once you arrive in Oudtshoorn, you will enjoy a free afternoon and evening. In the guesthouse you can enjoy dinner tonight.

Visiting a meerkat colony

Day 8: Sat, Mar 22

You will leave early today at sunrise to spot meerkats in the wild. Meerkats are part of the so-called shy 5 which also includes the bat-eared fox, armadillo, porcupine and armadillo. Upon arrival at the meerkats' dens, you will be treated to a hot cup of coffee and a comfortable chair as you watch the meerkats awaken from their slumber. Soon the little animals feel completely at ease, and start frolicking or searching for food.

After these pleasant scenes, you will return to the hotel, where a full breakfast awaits you.

Please note: this activity can only be offered in dry weather, as meerkats do not leave their burrows when it rains (can we blame them?).



On to Kariega Game Reserve

📍 ZA Kenton-on-Sea

Day 8: Sat, Mar 22

A 5.5 hour drive is scheduled today, again along beautiful trails and this time with a bit of coastal route. You will drive through Garden Route National Park with its spectacular cliffs, waterfalls and rivers. Since you will make another stop here later in the trip, I recommend driving briskly today to the highlight of this trip.

Over the next few days, you will go on safari in the phenomenal Kariega Game Reserve. Covering a generous 11 000 hectares, you can spot Big Five game here at any time of day, as well as some endangered species such as the Cape Mountain zebra, black rhino and black harrier. The most unique experience of this three-day tour is that you will spend the night in a boutique hotel among the wildlife, away from the world, under an endless starry sky.

After you have checked in, you will depart already on a first *sundowner* safari in an open 4×4, while you search for wildlife together with a guide.

Back at the reserve, you can relax before dinner is served.

Spotting the Big 5

Day 9: Sun, Mar 23

You set off on safari for the next two days with a local guide/Big 5 omnivore. Together you will look for lions, leopards, rhinos, elephants and buffalo, as well as giraffes, hippos, hyenas, impalas and kudu. Be sure to leave before the sun rises, as it has its advantages. The lions, leopards and hyenas return from hunting at that time and are thus much easier to spot than during the day, when they sleep hidden in the shade in the long grass or in a tree.

At noon, you always return to the lodge for an authentic South African lunch and a moment of rest by the pool. In the afternoon you will have a choice of activities, such as guided bush walks, a river cruise on the winding Bushmans River, a canoe trip or a *sundowner* safari.

So there is something for everyone!

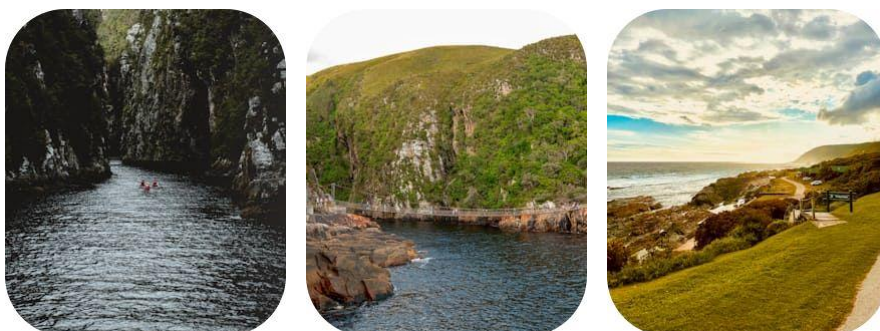

Day 12: Wed, Mar 26

You have the day free to explore Tsitsikamma National Park on your own.

Close to your hotel starts the Otter Trail, a multi-day hike along ponds, waterfalls, rivers and, as icing on the cake, a whole section of hiking along the beautiful coastline. You can hike a small portion of this challenging trail today, to the waterfall and back.

The hike begins at the front desk of Storms River Park, where you will be given a trail map. Be sure to test your fear of heights here and clamber across the Suspension suspension bridge to the other side of the Storms River. Next, hike quite a bit along the coast until you encounter the Jerling River waterfall. The waterfall plunges into a large pool, the perfect place for a break and perhaps a dip in the cool water.

Day 13: Thu, Mar 27

After breakfast, you will trek for 2 hours towards Knysna, one of the most beautiful places on the Garden Route with beautiful beaches and bays. This small cozy town is dominated by "The Heads," the high rock cliffs that form the entrance to the Atlantic Ocean. The water here flows into the lagoon with incredible force.

Once you arrive, you are free for the rest of the day.

Day 13: Thu, Mar 27

You have today free in Knysna to fill the day yourself. That's not at all difficult here, as there really is plenty to do.

Half an hour inland you will find the Knysna Elephant Park where elephants are taken care of that were previously used in circuses and shows. There you can observe the sweet animals in their natural habitat and give the keepers a hand with feeding.

Knysna is also known for its delicious oyster tours. The farms are usually located at the edge of the lagoon, where the water is clean and nutritious for the oysters. The farms use different techniques to grow them: special nets or cages are placed in the water to grow the oysters.

Watch as the oysters are removed from the water, or sign up for an oyster tour where you can watch the breeding process up close. The highlight of such a tour is, of course, tasting these delicacies. They are then taken fresh from the water and served on the spot.

As you sail further out into the ocean toward Brenton-on-Sea and Buffalo Bay, you will be joined by playful dolphins, seals, penguins and colorful seabirds. Be sure to bring your camera, because during the hour and a half boat ride, it is guaranteed not to stand still.

On to Swellendam

📍 ZA Swellendam

Day 14: Fri, Mar 28

After breakfast, you will depart for your final stop on the Garden Route: the historic town of Swellendam. This third-oldest town in South Africa has a rich history dating back to the country's early colonial period, something you will soon notice by the beautiful colonial houses that date back to the 18th century. The drive there takes 3 hours.

The rest of the afternoon and evening you are free to explore the nearby nature. Swellendam lies at the foot of the Langeberg mountain range and on the banks of the Breede River, which makes this town the ideal base for hiking or a panoramic drive in the area.

For example, you can follow the R60 to Ashton, a beautiful scenic route with phenomenal views of the valley around Ashton.

In addition, you can also visit the Bontebok National Park, home to the rare Bontebok antelope. This park lends itself perfectly to beautiful walks or a lovely picnic at one of the many picnic spots overlooking the Breede River.
